Washington FFA Crowns New State Winning Team in the Food Science and Technology Career Development Event

Pullman, WA; Sumner FFA was announced as the state winning Food Science and Technology Career Development Event (CDE) team for the third year in a row.

The Food Science and Technology CDE gains an awareness in FFA members in regard to the food science & technology, marketing, and management sectors of the agricultural industry. Students are graded as both individuals and teams during this event. This CDE consists of a team product development presentation, an objective test, triangle tests, and aroma identification. Teams consist of up to five members, but only four individual's points count toward their final team standing.

In celebration of their continued success Sumner FFA Members said, "We have learned so much—the GMP's and many factoring practices alike. We are so excited to be heading back to Indianapolis this fall."

The team will be competing at the 2024 National Convention and Expo this October. They will have the opportunity to compete against competitors from all 50 states, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands for the national title.
